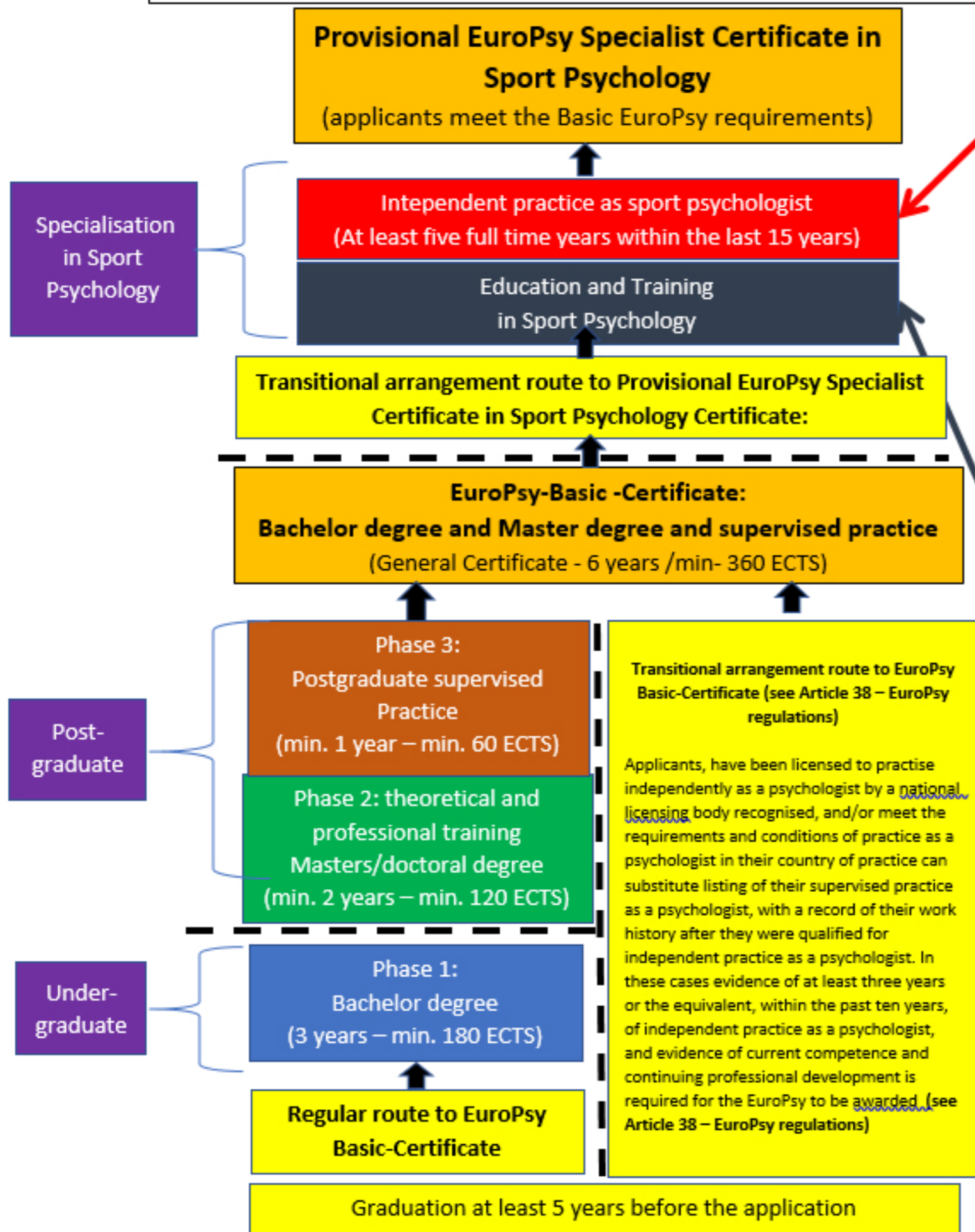


Pathways to the Provisional EuroPsy Specialist Certificate in Sport Psychology – transitional arrangement route



Show evidence of independent practice as sport psychologist of at least five full time years within the last 15 years. Applicants should report and summarize research, education and counselling, intervention addressed to athletes, to teams, sport services and organizations. The work experience can be documented through the following items:

- Years/months during which a particular work role has been fulfilled
- Name of description of the work role
- Organization where the role has been carried out
- Responsibilities associated with the role
- Activities performed as part of the role
- Competencies developed as a result of performing (some of) the activities in that role

Education and Training must have been done in sport and exercise psychology. There is a wide range of different types of professional education and training. This experience may also include personal training or other arrangements to ensure that practitioners are aware of and can manage appropriately their personal involvement in, and contribution to, the processes of the sport psychology service they practice (e.g. self-awareness in different settings).

These requirements make evident that the specialist certificate is the result of activities (study and learning, work experiences, development of competencies) conducted after the graduation.
